Corporate Representatives

The certificate of appointment must be lodged with the Company and/or the Company's share registry before the Meeting.

Votes on Resolutions

You may direct your proxy how to vote by placing a mark in the 'FOR', 'AGAINST' or 'ABSTAIN' box opposite the Resolution. All your votes will be cast in accordance with such a direction unless you indicate only a portion of voting rights are to be voted on the Resolutions by inserting the percentage or number of Shares you wish to vote in the appropriate box or boxes. If you do not mark any of the boxes on the Resolutions, your proxy may vote as he or she chooses. If you mark more than one box on a Resolution your vote on that Resolution will be invalid.

As proxies will not be able to physically attend the Meeting, Shareholders are encouraged to consider appointing the Chair as their directed proxy for this Meeting, or otherwise complete the directions for each resolution on the Proxy Form. You can direct your proxy to vote "For", "Against" or "Abstain" from voting on, a resolution by marking the appropriate box in the enclosed Proxy Form.

Chair Voting Undirected Proxies

If the Chair is your proxy, the Chair will cast your votes in accordance with your directions on the Proxy Form. If you do not mark any of the boxes on the Resolutions, then you expressly authorise the Chair to vote your undirected proxies at his/her discretion.

Accordingly, transactions registered after that time will be disregarded in determining entitlements to attend and vote at the Meeting.

2. RESOLUTION 1 – RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR – MR DOMENIC MARTINO

2.1 General

The Constitution sets out the requirements for determining which Directors are to retire by rotation at an annual general meeting.

Mr Domenic Martino, who has served as a Director since 6 May 2009 and who was last re-elected at the 2018 Annual General Meeting held on 30 November 2018, retires by rotation and seeks re-election.

2.2 Qualifications and other material directorships

Mr Martino is a Chartered Accountant and an experienced director of ASX listed companies. Previously CEO of Deloitte Touch Tohmatsu in Australia, he has significant experience in the development of "microcap" companies.

Mr Martino is a key player in the re-birth of a broad grouping of ASX companies including Cokal Limited, Pan Asia Corporation Limited, Clean Global Energy Limited (renamed Citation Resources Ltd) and NuEnergy Capital Limited. He has a strong reputation in China, with a lengthy track record of operating in Papua New Guinea (PNG) and Indonesia, where he has successfully closed key energy and resources deals with key local players. He has proven track record in capital raisings across a range of markets. Mr Martino was a recipient of the Centenary Medal 2003 for his service to Australian society through business and the arts.

2.3 Board recommendation

The Board supports the re-election of Mr Domenic Martino and recommends that Shareholders vote in favour of Resolution 1.
